Responsibilities:

- From time-to-time the utility may deem it necessary to require work assignments that are within the supervisor's capabilities but outside the position of the supervisor. This may include but is not limited to planning/auditing work plans or other duties as assigned.
- Perform other related duties as required or assigned

Requirements:

- Work schedule consisting of a minimum of 40 hours per week between the hours of 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM.
- Full-time presence on the utilities property
- Must have a minimum of two (2) years of experience in management or leadership position
- Must have a minimum of five (5) years of experience in the utility line clearance industry
- Must be a Certified Arborist

- Must possess a valid Pesticide Applicators License or able to obtain within twelve (12) months of hire
- English is the primary language and the ability to speak Spanish is desirable
- Must be proficient communicator with the ability to resolve member complaints, employee issues, and concerns
- Proficiency in the operation of personal computers and tablets
- Proficient and skilled in MS Office Products with emphasis in Outlook, Excel, & Word
- Must be proficient in the use of the utilities software within three (3) months of hire
- Must be able to train and educate newly hired CUF's in the use of the utilities vegetation management software
