Employment Opportunity: LandVest Timberland has openings available (summer 2018) for Seasonal/Temporary Forest Technician in our Northern Maine region. This region comprises over one million acres and is covered from our four District offices noted above. The Seasonal Forest Technician position is primarily an entry-level operations forester position. The position requires a person in good physical condition, one who is willing to live on site at the various office locations, and provide a woods ready 4WD pick-up (Transportation is available for some positions). Minimal educational requirements are course work in Forestry. The successful candidate should also be familiar with computer applications (MS Office & ArcGIS ideally), and be familiar with GPS units &/or digital data recording units and the collection and use of GPS data.

Depending on location, the position will report to the Northern Maine Regional Forester/Property Manager James O'Malley, Operations Manager Jason Castonguay or District Forester Thomas Coleman.

The tasks are summarized as:

- Work closely with Operation Foresters on various aspects of forest operations, harvesting, thinning, & planting
- Layout of harvest units and marking of timber for harvest
- Layout of road construction/maintenance activities
- Implementation of pre and post harvest inventory
- GPS work
- Property administration: potential to address lease and other recreational use of the managed tracts
- Boundary line maintenance
- Timber cruising

Other considerations for the position:

- The candidate ideally will have some base knowledge of Maine tree species.
- Position may entail living on site 3-4 nights per week. A North Maine Woods ready 4WD vehicle (10 ply tires for example) may need to be provided by the successful candidates, current mileage reimbursement is standard IRS rate at a minimum, and higher depending on location. As noted above a suitable truck for daily use is available at certain locations.
