(Forest Management Technician I)
(Labor Grade 10, \$14.39 per hour)

The summer technicians will assist forest management staff conducting forest resource sampling and inventory at Nash Stream Forest, and occasionally assisting with timber harvest preparation and marking on other State Reservations. Applicants should be familiar with the use of compass, prism, and GPS. Duties require travel throughout the northern portion of the state. The use of personal vehicles will be expected. Applicants must possess a valid driver's license and insurance as well as reliable transportation. Mileage will be reimbursed at the State rate of 54.5 cents per mile.

This position requires at least two years of formal forestry training from an accredited college or technical institute with major study in forestry or wildlife. No experience is required to apply. Students with only one year of formal training should still apply. There may be positions at a slightly lower pay grade.
