Position Title: Forest Health Program Associate

Location: Fort Collins, Colorado

Salary: \$52,000 to \$56,000, commensurate with experience

Employment Status: This full-time, regular appointment will be a Colorado State University Administrative Professional employee.

Closing Date: Applications will be accepted until the position is filled; however, applicants should submit all application materials by 11:59pm on January 17, 2023 for full consideration.

Under the direct supervision of the Forest Entomologist, the Forest Health Program Associate position will assist with and provide technical support on projects related to the Forest Health Program. The position will involve independent field work as directed by the Forest Entomologist to achieve research objectives and assist landowners and CSFS Field Offices across the state. The Forest Health Program Associate position will be directly involved in statewide research projects that involve trapping and identifying forest pests in collaboration with scientists from the USDA Forest Service and other agencies. The candidate will be asked to assist in developing outreach materials related to Forest Health (workshops, research, fact sheets, aerial survey, etc.) The position will support broad outreach efforts to reach diverse audiences.

Please specifically address how you meet the required and preferred job qualifications in the cover letter of your application. After the closing date, please allow at least five to six weeks for us to review your application materials and determine those candidates we plan to invite to interview. If you are not selected for an interview, we will send you notification when the process is complete. Should you be invited to an in-person interview, the Colorado State Forest Service will cover all reasonable travel expenses per candidate. At the time of on-campus interviews, application materials of finalist candidates will be made available to Forest Service and other relevant constituents. References will not be contacted without the candidates being notified.

Required Job Qualifications

- A bachelor's degree in Natural Resources or a related field.
- Two years professional forestry, forest health, entomology, or other relevant natural resource experience is required.
- Must be legally authorized to work in the United States by the employment start date; Colorado State Forest Service will not sponsor a visa for this position
