Summary/Objective

Primary responsibilities will focus on managing all business processes related to strategic and tactical planning support of forest operations for F&W's Western land base. Tasks will include ESG (carbon, wind, solar, easement, etc...) project development, harvest scheduling, business feasibility analysis, business valuation, economic analysis, and silvicultural prescription analysis. Requires experience with cash flow analysis, harvest scheduling systems, growth and yield software and relational databases. A strong understanding of timber and carbon markets as well as management practices is required as well as the ability to communicate business process and results to clients.
