SUMMARY: The Hood River County Forestry Department is seeking a career-oriented Forester with the technical skills to perform various phases of a forest management program to include all timber stand improvement activity such as planting, vegetation control, PCT, collecting and entering timber stand improvement field data, slash burning, and providing support with timber sales including sale layout, timber cruising, road layout and contract logging inspections. Qualified applicants should have a Bachelor of Science Degree in Forestry or Forest Engineering with 1 or more years' experience in forest management. This role will need an Oregon Public Pesticide Applicator's license, or the ability to obtain within a year.

Work Environment: Employee works in an outdoor environment, may be exposed to mechanical, physical hazards, extreme temperatures, wetness and/or humidity. The terrain may be steep, uneven, brushy, unstable, difficult.

Applicants should be self-motivated, enthusiastic, and able to assume a team role in the County Forestry Department.

WAGE RANGE: Forester Wage range \$30.57 to \$45.25 per hour, plus benefits to include health insurance and full payment of Public Employees Retirement System (PERS) contributions.
