



## Position: Technical Forester – Technical Services

The Technical Forester will also support the forest management planning team through miscellaneous harvest schedule and valuation services. There will be opportunities to work with the Real Estate and Valuation Services team as occasion arises. This position reports directly to the Larson & McGowin Inventory Manager.

Candidate will occasionally manage projects across the southeast. Travel outside of the local area will be required approximately 20% of the time. Necessary travel costs to be reimbursed by the company.

### Primary Duties & Responsibilities

- Prepare timber inventory cruises including cruise design, plot layout, map preparation, etc.
- Recruit, manage & supervise timber inventory cruisers including sub-contractors and as well as other company foresters
- Supervise and implement timber cruise activity and oversee audit plots
- Compile cruise information and distribute internally and/or externally to LM Property Management and outside clients
- Prepare formal cruise reports and maps as needed
- Prepare inventory data for incorporation into LM forest inventory management system
- Maintain a safe work environment for company personnel, contractors, and other stakeholders

  - Must be a Registered Forester in Alabama or meet the necessary requirements to obtain this designation within 2 years from date of hire

  - Must be capable of working in remote outdoor locations in various weather and forest conditions

  - Knowledge of any coding language a plus
