Primary Role: This is the Forestry Area Supervisor position in the Sandstone Forestry Administrative Area which consists of an area office in Sandstone and field stations in Cambridge and Forest Lake.

This position directs all the activities of the Division of Forestry Administrative Area, including the direct supervision of staff. The position directs Division of Forestry program implementation and promotes inter-disciplinary collaboration, cooperation and problem solving within the Area Administrative Unit. Occasional overnight travel required.

Schedule: The primary schedule is Monday – Friday, 8:00 am to 4:30 pm. Fire season can impact evening weekend and holiday hours.

Applicants must also possess broad range of experience with the following Forestry field operation programs: 1) State Land Management; 2) Resource Protection with an emphasis on fire suppression and management; 3) Forest Resource Information and Analysis with an emphasis on FIM; and 4) Cooperative Forest Management; and have an unrestricted Class D Driver's License with a clear driving record.
