**Primary Role:** The primary role of these positions is spent in the field suppressing wildfires, timber management, regeneration activities, forest inventory and ecological classification. In addition, the Division provides many opportunities for training and professional improvement. Contact the supervisor to find out more about a specific job or location.

**Schedule:** The primary schedule is Monday – Friday, 8:00 am to 4:30 pm. During fire season, foresters and technicians must work evenings, nights, weekends, and holidays and occasionally have to travel and work overnight to assist neighboring areas or participate in short mobility assignments.

Applicants must also possess knowledge of forest management practices and policies; have excellent leadership, organization, and human relations skills; the ability to communicate complex ideas clearly; the ability to resolve conflicts; and have an unrestricted driver's license.
