

NYS Department of Taxation and Finance-Senior Forest Appraiser Position, Raybrook, NY

This position may be filled as a 2-year traineeship.

For non-NYS employees, the Minimum Qualifications for Provisional Appointment are:

Forest Appraiser Trainee 1 minimum qualifications: A bachelor's or higher degree including or supplemented by 30 semester credit hours in general forestry, forest management and/or forest economics

OR

Forest Appraiser Trainee 2: you must possess beyond the minimum qualifications above, one year of professional experience in forest appraisal work

OR

Senior Forest Appraiser: you must possess beyond the minimum qualifications, two years of professional experience in forest appraisal work.

Note: Provisional appointments are made pending an exam and will be revoked if the selected candidate is not immediately reachable on the eligible list resulting from the next holding of the Civil Service Exam.

Duties include: Determines the appraised values of private and taxable state forest land; develops land, stumpage and waterfront schedules for the valuation of private and taxable state forest land; performs field reviews of forest land sales to determine logging conditions, species composition, age, quality and other relevant factors; researches, investigates, obtains and analyzes a variety of data to monitor market conditions for forest lands; contacts companies, operators, professional foresters and other sources to obtain information; assists in the development of documentation associated with litigation involving taxable state land; conducts training sessions for regional and central office staff and assessors regarding valuation of forest lands.

This position requires some travel: travel percentage 10%
