Position: Forest Technician

Northwest Management, Inc., a full-service natural resource consulting firm, located in Moscow, ID, is seeking highly motivated individuals with forestry background.

Status: Seasonal Position, 3 to 10-month appointments available

Time Frame: Early in 2022 through November 2022 (time frame is flexible)

Location: Forest Technician will be based out of the main office in Moscow, ID. Travel out of town is required to fulfill the requirements of this position, with expenses paid by the company (bunkhouse is available for use when working in the Moscow area). This position works in outdoor settings on forested landscapes and requires extended time in the field on forestry projects. Field personnel will be walking on uneven terrain while conducting field work in all types of weather.

Duties: Forest Technician will work under the direct supervision of a Professional Forester or Natural Resource Specialist within the following departments of Northwest Management:

1. Inventory Services: Collection of data using both traditional and LiDAR assisted inventory methods intended to develop estimates of marketable timber volume and provide clients with detailed data of forest health and condition.
2. Forest Health Management: Designation and implementation of harvest and site activity boundaries, riparian buffers and forest roads.
3. Hazard Management (Fire & Fuels): Applications of various prescribed burning methods (drip torch, propane, and Terra-torch) intended to reduce hazardous fuel loads on client ownerships. Possibility for assignments on a Wildland Fire Engine.
4. Any other opportunities within the Natural Resource industry that may occur.

Preferred Qualifications for Candidates:

- College Junior or older pursuing a Forestry or other Natural Resources-related degree
- Minimum of one (1) year natural resource-related experience
- Experience with timber cruising, inventory and forest measurements • Wildland fire, or prescribed burning techniques • Experience in timber sales preparation
