## Seasonal Field Forester

**Position Availability & Time Frame:** Positions are open for qualified candidates available to begin field work in late winter and early spring. Work will continue through the end of the calendar year or longer. Time frames and start dates can be flexible. **3-month positions are available for students.**

**Location:** Based out of the main office in Moscow, Idaho. Extensive “out of town” traveling and driving is required, with expenses paid by the company. A bunkhouse is available for use for those not currently living within the Moscow area. This position works at outdoor settings on forested landscapes and requires extended time in the field on forestry projects. Field personnel work on uneven terrain, while working in all types of weather.

**Duties:** The Field Forester position predominately revolves around performing inventory services. The primary role will involve working closely under the direct supervision of a Professional Forester or Natural Resource Specialist, with most of the time dedicated to:

**Inventory Services:** the foremost responsibility will be the execution of inventory services. This entails the collection of data utilizing both conventional techniques and cutting-edge LiDAR technology-assisted methods. These efforts are aimed at developing precise estimates of marketable timber volume and providing clients with comprehensive insights into forest health and condition.

**Exploring Other Natural Resource Opportunities:** Alongside the core inventory responsibilities, other encounters with diverse opportunities within the broader Natural Resource industry may occur as they arise such as:

- Forest Health Management: the designation and execution of harvest boundaries, riparian buffers, administration of planting initiatives, and the management of forest roads.
- Hazard Management (Fire and Fuels): There is the potential for assignments related to hazard management, particularly in the realm of fire and fuels. This may involve opportunities to work with a Wildland Fire Engine and the application of various prescribed burning methods. These activities are designed to mitigate hazardous fuel loads on client-owned properties.

- Having or pursuing a Forestry or other Natural Resources-related degree
- One field season of natural resource related experience
- Experience with timber cruising, inventory, and forest measurements, as well as timber sales preparation
- Familiarity with navigation using map, compass, GPS, and GIS applications
- History of working independently or as a crew member, with minimal supervision while maintaining a high quality of work
- Leadership and planning experience is highly beneficial
