Work will be based out of our Lassen District office in **Anderson, California**.

- Administer contracts for field operations including marketing, logging, and road construction

- Assist in reforestation activities, including planting and site preparation
- Forestry-related project work in a wide range of weather and field conditions

- A California Registered Professional Forester (RPF) license or the ability to qualify for, take, and pass the RPF exam after qualification through a combination of educational and/or work experience

- Excellent communication skills, self-motivated, and strong work ethic
- Proficient computer skills, including Microsoft Word, Excel, and GIS-based software programs

- Current valid drivers' license and the ability to operate a four-wheel drive vehicle and safely negotiate steep forest roads
