UNH Cooperative Extension has 2 job openings for County Extension Foresters—one is for Hillsborough County and the other is for Strafford/Belknap counties in New Hampshire. To conduct forestry education with landowners and others, and provide statewide programming in the areas of small lot forest management (Strafford/Belknap) or invasive species (Hillsborough).

Qualifications: Master's Degree required. Exceptional Bachelor Degree applicants with over 3 years related experience will be considered contingent on commitment to obtain a Master's Degree within seven years of hire. One degree must be in forestry and/or wildlife or closely related field. Experience in how to develop, implement and evaluate programs that encourage an ecological approach to long term forest stewardship on private and community owned properties is preferred.

Apply online for one or both of these positions and fill out an application for each position. The online system doesn't allow for one application to be used for two jobs.
